Dear Parent/Carer

I hope this letter finds you and your families well.

You will be aware that an announcement was made by the Prime Minister on Sunday, 10 May 2020 relating to the wider re-opening of schools. It was stated that students in Years 10 and 12 would have some 'face to face contact' with their teachers prior to the summer break.

Since this announcement we have been awaiting further guidance from the Government related to what 'face to face contact' should look like in practice. We expected this at the beginning of the week but unfortunately at the time of writing we have still not received anything.

As I am sure you will appreciate, any wider opening of the school under the current circumstances will take significant planning to safeguard all involved. **As such we will not be making any changes to the way the school is currently running until week commencing 8 June 2020 at the earliest.**

Staff will not be setting new work over the half-term holiday nor will they be expected to answer e-mails. Students will still be able to access Classcharts during the holiday. If you need to contact the school urgently during this time please use the office@holyfamilyschool.uk e-mail address. The regular setting of work via Classcharts will resume on Monday, 1 June 2020. We will be in contact again as soon as we can to confirm any changes in arrangements for Years 10 and 12.
