

It can be difficult to organise your school work each week, especially when it all arrives on a Monday. It can look a little overwhelming, so here are two examples of how to make your week easier.

Example 1 divides the works up so that you do two subjects per day.

Example timetable 1	
Monday	Maths MFL
Tuesday	English Art
Wednesday	Science RE
Thursday	Geography Computing
Friday	History PE

Example 2 is a different option where you do two subjects on a Monday, three on a Tuesday and Wednesday and one on a Thursday. With this option you get the day off on a Friday.

Example timetable 2	
Monday	Maths MFL
Tuesday	English History Art
Wednesday	Science PE RE
Thursday	Geography Computing
Friday	Day off

You can decide at the beginning of each week which option works best for you, but it is much better if you just do two or three subjects per day.

You may have your own way that you prefer and if you get all of your work done, that's great. You can change the subjects around too but try and do one subject that you enjoy and one that you find more of a challenge, then you are not overwhelmed.
