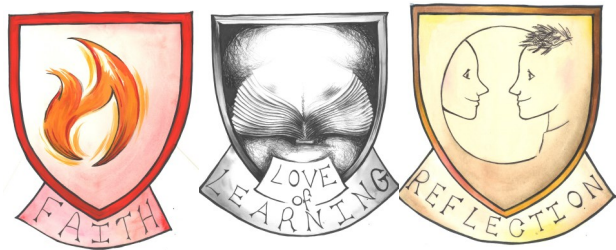




Awakening Minds in Psychology
