As part of our comprehensive transition programme, we will be working very closely with your Year 6 teachers and our new Year 7 students will be visited at their primary school by me, Mrs Moran, during our summer term, should any protective factors in place connected to the Covid 19 situation allow. - Mrs Moran will be visiting the primary schools, to meet all our new students, after the May half term holiday. Students should arrive at the school's main hall for 8.35 am; in their primary school uniform. They will meet their new Form Tutor and other students who will be in their Form in September. They will spend the day sampling some lessons. Students will require either a packed lunch or £2.40 for a school lunch. The end of the school day is 2.50 pm.
