MI6 – SECRET INTELLIGENCE SERVICES

Founded in 1909, SIS (or MI6) exists to protect the UK's people, economy and interests from overseas threats. We help other countries with whom we share values of democracy, international law and universal human rights.

We work secretly overseas to gather intelligence from people and Organisations. Our work is often referred to as 'espionage' or 'spying'. It has to be done in secret to protect our staff, our agents, our technology and ultimately the UK. 'Agents' are individuals who choose to help us collect intelligence.

We have three core areas of focus:

Counter Terrorism – stopping terrorist attacks in the UK, against our interests overseas, and supporting our allies

Disrupting Hostile State Activity – tackling threats from hostile and malign states, promoting the UK's prosperity and influencing international affairs Cyber – promoting and defending the UK's cyber realm and using our cyber expertise to reduce threats.

Skills Builder Employers can judge a CV in seconds.

If you want to bag that interview, make sure your CV stands out from the crowd.

- 1. Adjust your CV to the course you are applying to.
- Include a personal statement paragraph where you are telling them why you suitable for the course.
- Don't leave gaps in your CV or employers will wonder what happened in those blank periods Check your spelling and grammar.
- Make sure you put down any work experience or voluntary work you have completed.
- 5. Any clubs you belong to, explain what you do.
- 6. Keep it up to date.
- 7. Be concise 2 pages'max
- 8. Don't use buzzwords, you will need to produce evidence of the word.
- Example Team Player (explain in context why you are a good team player)

START has a CV Builder within the Programme, all you need to do is to login to START with your username and password, look under Work Preparation section and look for CV. Do not put anything in your CV that you cannot back up with evidence.

Final CV Tip:

Focus on key words that grab a reader's attention. More industries are adopting digital solutions to help them recruit and look for these words by computer!
