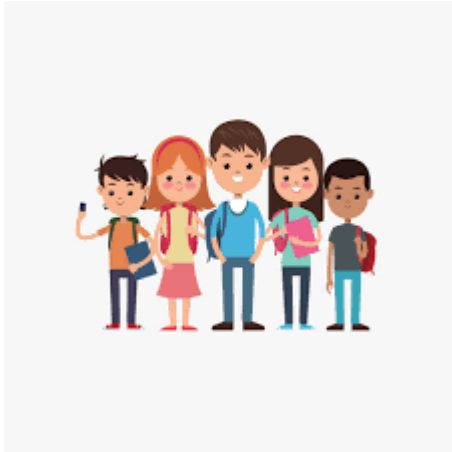


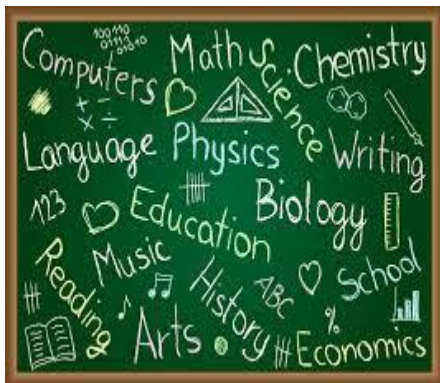
# Year 7 Opportunities and Worries
