As school finishes for the half-term break, I wanted to write to thank you for your support throughout the first half-term of the school year.

If you would like your child(ren) to be vaccinated, please return the consent for to us as soon as possible if you have not already done so. If you have given consent, we will be in touch to let you know our allocated date for vaccinations to be administered once we have it.

May I remind you that there is lots of useful information regarding all aspects of school life on our website. In particular, there is a Safeguarding tab under the Parents and Students sections on the site. This section contains information which may be useful for people facing challenges at what continues to be a difficult time for many. There is also an option to report any concerns you may have. This facility will be monitored over the half-term holiday. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you need to.
