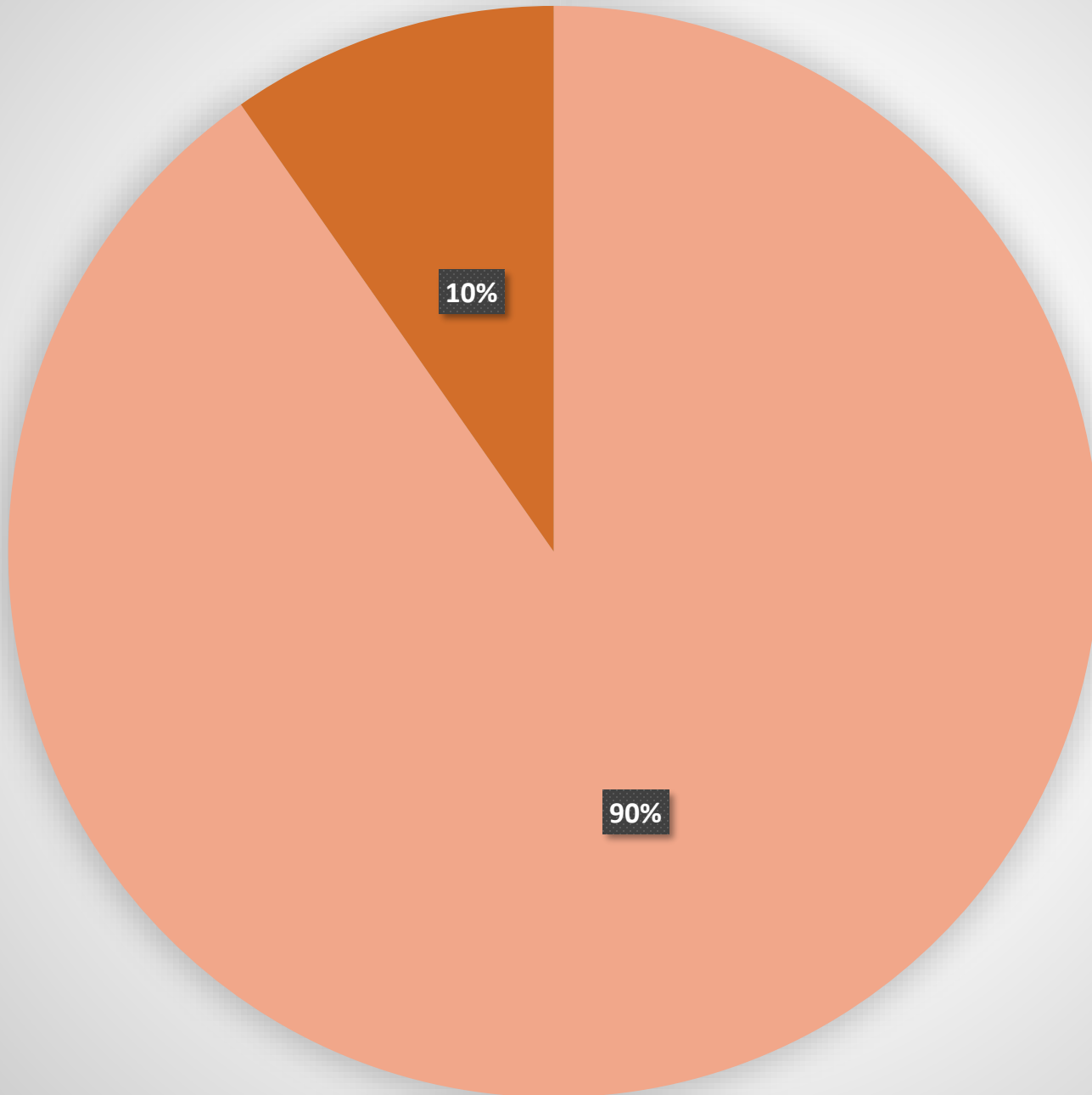
“Do not merely listen to the word. Do what it says.”

Virtues help everybody in our community to know what good conduct is, to analyse right from wrong, and to understand how to put our values into practice through excellent moral behaviour.

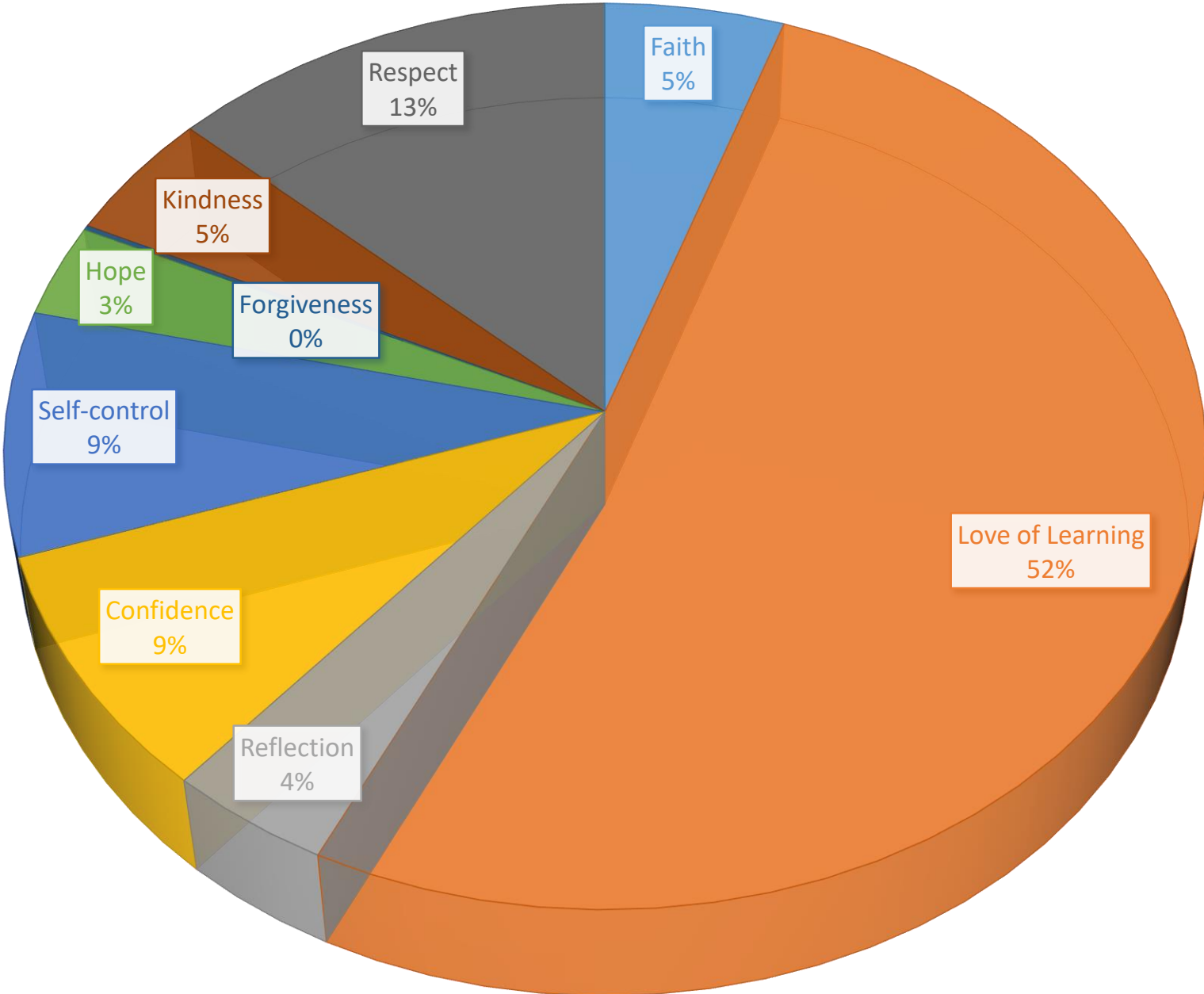

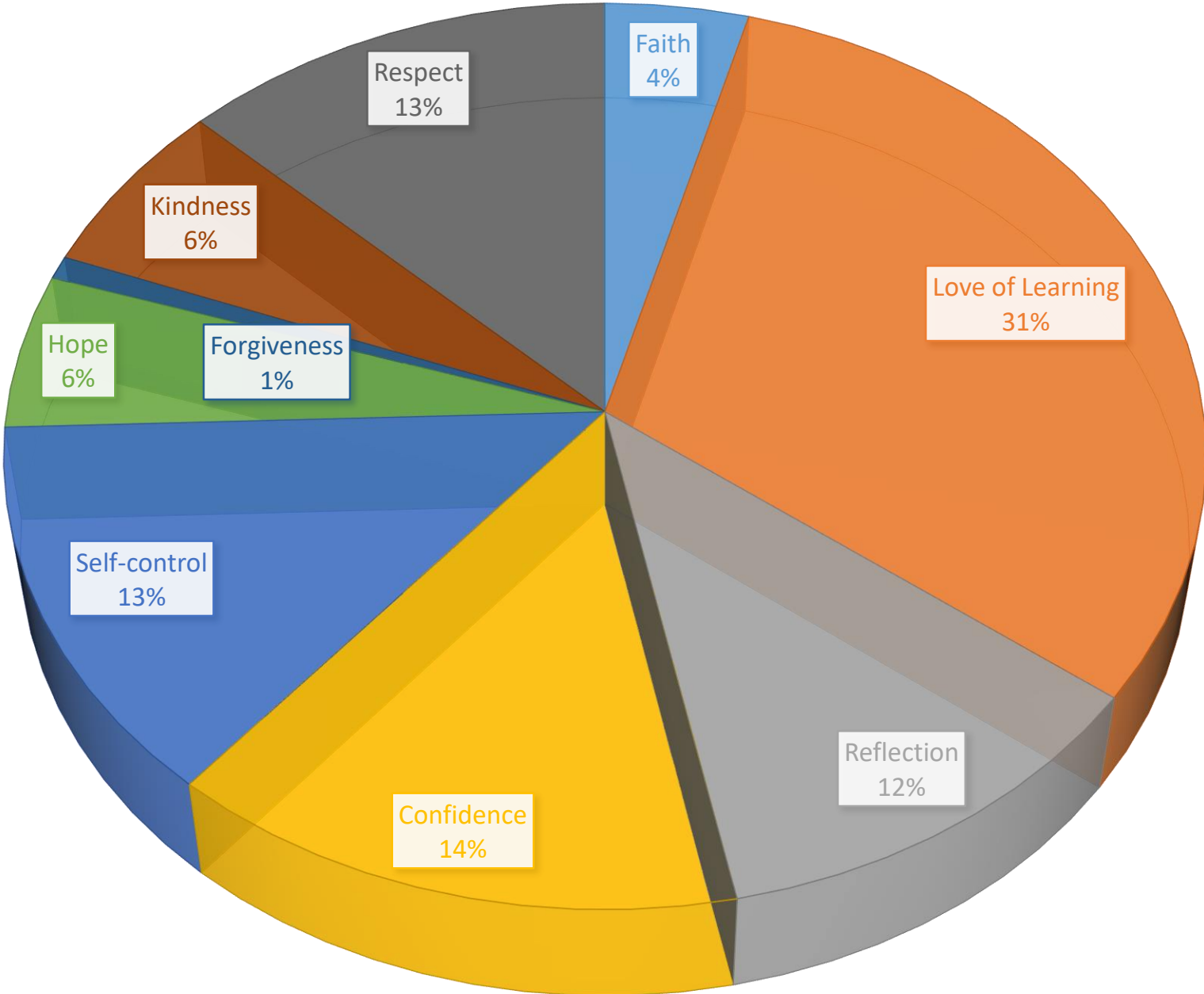

PROPORTIONS OF VIRTUES AWARDED 2020-21

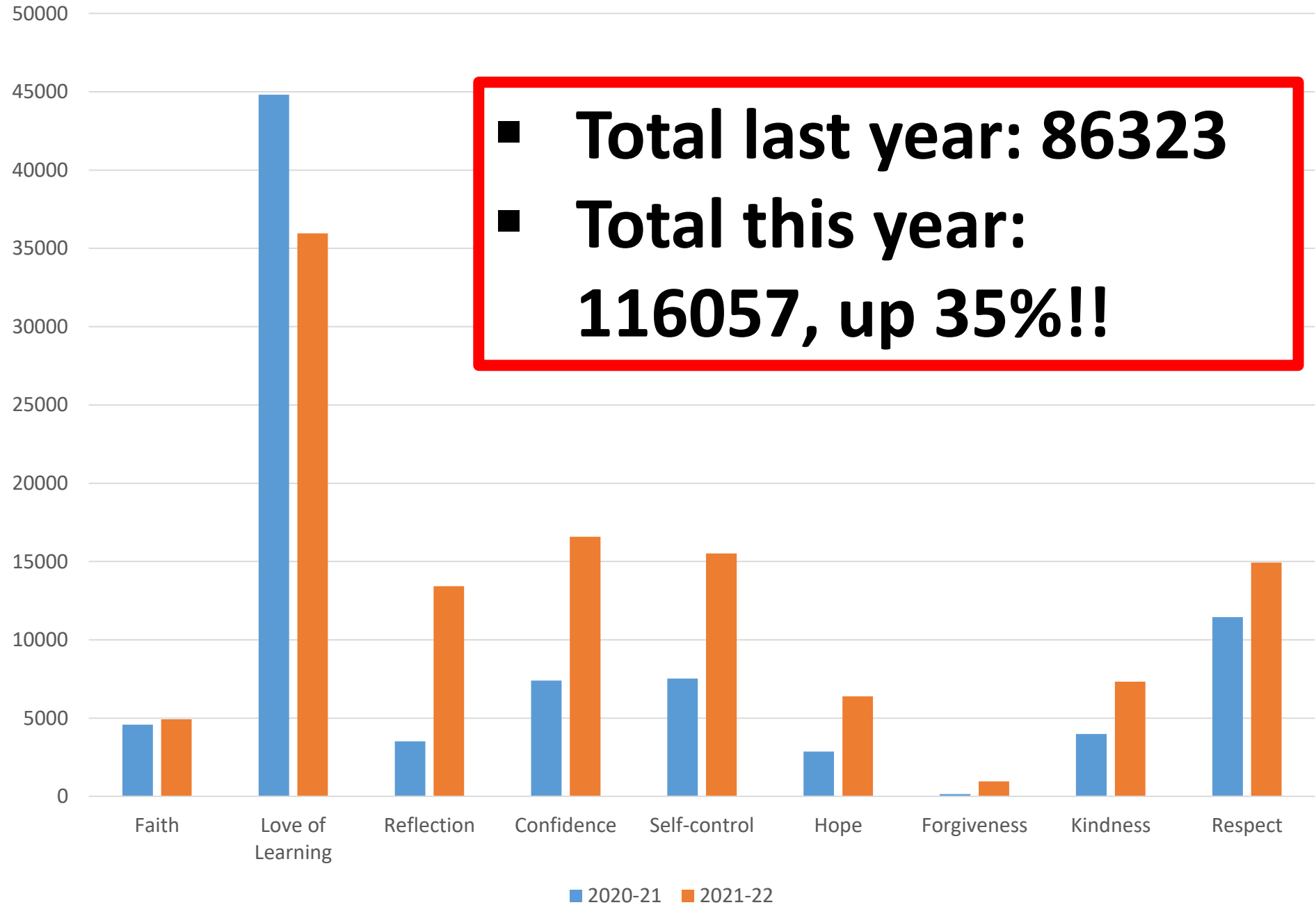


PROPORTIONS OF VIRTUES AWARDED 2021-22

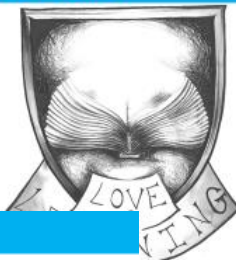
Virtue of the Week – HOPE
