Careers and Work related extra- curricular enrichment

A wide range of careers and work related learning activities are planned to be embedded into the school life. We aim to allow for as many opportunities as possible for learners to have contact with employers and employees through guest speakers in lessons and assemblies or special workshop activities delivered by external partners and business organisations.

All guest speakers to school are encouraged to share their own career path history with learners to give an insight as to how they came to be in their current career along with any encouraging career planning advice.

Frequent visits to external organisations are organised to incorporate a careers dimension in subjects where possible.
