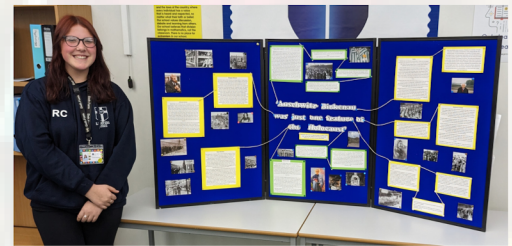
## Erin - Lourdes Pilgrimage
