#### Rationale

#### Description of the order of teaching and reasoning behind the structure.

In Component 1 (portfolio) students develop responses to initial starting points, project briefs or specified tasks and realise intentions informed by research, the development and refinement of ideas and meaningful engagement with selected sources. Responses will include evidence of drawing for different purposes and needs, with written annotation.

#### Students are facilitated to:

- Choose a starting point from own ideas or past exam papers, supplied by Art dept.
- Select an appropriate Artist and study their work by making drawings, paintings and annotated research pages in sketchbook.
- Experiment with mediums and techniques to develop skills and outcomes.
- Record observations by taking own photos to develop project in original and personal way.

#### Key Resources (textbooks/videos/websites)

Resources that will help the students with their independence, homework and revision. Copies of any resources can be placed in the LRC or on the shared drive for students to access.

Students use cartridge paper/canvas/wood and make pieces of Art based on their personal project.
