As soon as our students join HFCS in Year 7, we encourage them to start thinking about their future careers and the steps needed to follow the correct route. Whilst some students already have a definite career dream, others need time to explore the options that are ahead of them.

A wide range of careers and work related learning activities are planned to be embedded into the school life. We aim to allow for as many opportunities as possible for learners to have contact with employers and employees through guest speakers in lessons and assemblies or special workshop activities delivered by external partners and business organisations.

All guest speakers to school are encouraged to share their own career path history with learners to give an insight as to how they came to be in their current career along with any encouraging career planning advice.

Frequent visits to external organisations are organised to incorporate a careers dimension in subjects where possible.
