| Week 29<br>wc 28 <sup>th</sup> April | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Apply performance skills (facial expression and focus) to play a character.</li><li>• Demonstrate your ability to work successfully in collaboration.</li><li>• Demonstrate your ability to start to memorise your lines.</li></ul> |
| Week 30<br>wc 5 <sup>th</sup> May    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Understand and be able to memorise a Slapstick scene.</li><li>• Be able to put that scene on the stage using all the techniques and blocking.</li></ul>   |
| Week 31<br>wc 12 <sup>th</sup> May   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Identify the features of a slapstick fight</li><li>• Create a slapstick battle safely using techniques learnt in previous lessons</li></ul>   |
