Week 28 wc 21 st April	Lesson 1: Bullying – Rights, Responsibilities, and the Law <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Explain what bullying is (including online and indirect).• Identify moral and legal rights/responsibilities around bullying.• Recognise how policies (school/law) aim to challenge it.
Week 29 wc 28 th April	Lesson 2: Reactions and Impact – What Happens When We Don't Step In? <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Describe long-term effects of bullying on individuals and groups.• Explain why some people respond unhealthily to bullying.• Evaluate how bystanders and wider society can either help or harm.• Identify sources of support and when to use them.
Week 30 wc 5 th May	Lesson 3: Gangs, Group Pressure, and Why People Join <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Explain the appeal and risks of gangs.• Describe healthy vs unhealthy group dynamics.• Explain exit strategies and what to do if worried about gang behaviour.
Week 31 wc 12 th May	Lesson 5: Project Challenge – “Be the Change” Campaign <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Demonstrate understanding of key issues around bullying and gang pressure.• Work collaboratively to produce a positive message or solution.• Reflect on personal values and how to be a safe challenger.• Present ideas in a clear, creative, and meaningful way.
