

Music Year 9 Learning Intentions Summer Term 2 2024-2025

| Pop Music Origins | |
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| WEEK 33 wc 2 nd June | <p>Rock 'n' Roll context. Introduce Elvis Presley.</p> <p>Demo Hound Dog melody with 12 bar blues chords.</p> <p>Students attempt to put the 2 parts together in pairs.</p> |
| WEEK 34 wc 9 th June | <p>Introduce 'the Beatles'.</p> <p>Play 'Let it Be'.</p> <p>Demo the chords.</p> <p>Students work to play the chords and sing the lyrics at the same time.</p> <p>May be in pairs/ small groups, but all must attempt the chords and lyrics.</p> |
| WEEK 35 wc 16 th June | <p>Introduction to Song Structure.</p> <p>Build a song with structure words.</p> <p>Listen to some songs, breaking down the structure and analysing.</p> |
| WEEK 36 wc 23 rd June | <p>Demo 4 chord songs.</p> <p>Highlight the use of only 4 chords – less complicated than some Beatles songs.</p> <p>Students rehearse to play the 4 chords fluently.</p> |
| WEEK 37 wc 30 th June | <p>3 options of songs given to students – they pick one and rehearse it.</p> <p>Option to record into garageband.</p> |
| WEEK 38 wc 7 th July | <p>3 options of songs given to students – they pick one and rehearse it. (Continued)</p> <p>Option to record into garageband.</p> |
| WEEK 39 wc 14 th July | <p>Students perform/share in small groups.</p> <p>Quiz given on pop music origins (Blues, Rock 'n' Roll, Song Structure, Chords)</p> |
