Week 34 w.c. 9 th June	To learn about drugs and young people's attitudes and behaviours regarding use. To define the term addiction and drugs. To evaluate what support networks are available to help support those in need.
Week 35 w.c. 16 th June	Learn about the potential legal consequences of using illegal drugs. To explain the legal terms 'possession', 'supply' and 'intent to supply' in relation to drugs. To explain the short- and long-term legal consequences of being found in possession of, using, selling or supplying different classes of drugs.
Week 36 w.c. 23 rd June	To understand how to manage and evaluate potential risks with regards to drugs. To explain the short- and long-term legal consequences of being found in possession of, using, selling or supplying different classes of drugs.
Week 37 w.c. 30 th June	Learn about the short and long-term effects of alcohol and cannabis use on individuals Describe some of the health risks associated with occasional and problematic substance use Recognise and challenge myths related to cannabis use and drinking alcohol
Week 38 w.c. 7 th July	Learn how to manage peer and other influence in relation to substance use Explain the physical, emotional and social consequences substance use might have for individuals Demonstrate strategies they could use if someone offers them something that might be harmful or illegal Explain the potential impact of others' views on drugs, alcohol and smoking on decision-making Explain what support is available to people who are concerned about substance use and how to access it for themselves or others
