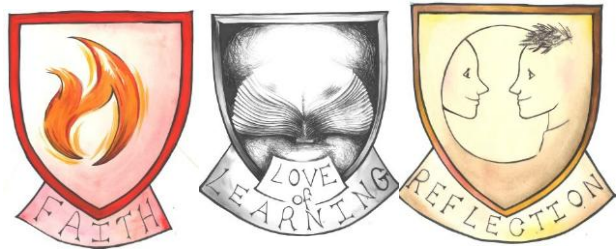
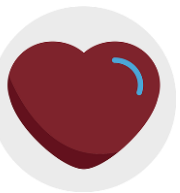


Awakening Minds in Classical Civilisation
