CONCEPTS

Introduction to repetition – Students will be introduced to dramatic and rehearsal techniques and be able to implement these to create theatre and storytelling. Techniques will be revisited to cement students' knowledge.

Subject language – students will be able to explain the processes that a performer develops to create art using specific subject language.

Group work – students will be able to work in small groups as well as individually. Students will understand compromise and the art of listening to ideas and trying things out.

Evaluation – students will be able to evaluate their own and other peoples work through verbal feedback and direction given within classes. Students will be able to act on feedback to enhance their knowledge and learning.
