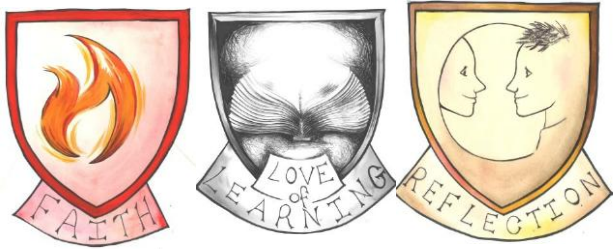


Awakening Minds in History
